Language Arts: We continue to work on recognizing the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. The students are practicing how to write their names correctly.

* **Sight Words** that your child should know: "name", "I", "like", "and", "the", "a", "to", "see", "are", "we", "an", "can", "come", "me", "you", "at", "here", "is", "it", "in", "he", "she", "my", "be" and all of the **color** and **number** words (zero through ten).

Math: We are practicing counting and writing the numbers 0-10, as well as, recognizing the number words zero through ten.

Religion: In this chapter, the children have been exploring their individuality and learning about God's special love for each one of us.

Science / Social Studies:  The students have listened to the story of the First Thanksgiving. We have compared the first thanksgiving celebration to modern day gatherings. We have also discussed ways in which the pilgrims' lives were similar to and different from our lives today.
