Language Arts: The letters and sounds that we have worked with so far this year are: /a/, /s/, /m/, /t/, /p/, /c/, /n/, /f/, /b/ and /i/.

* **Sight Words** that your child should know: "name", "I", "like", "and", "the", "a", "to", "see", "are", "we", "an", "can", "come", "me", "you", "at", "here", "is", "it", "in", "he", "she", "my", "be", "what", "with", "look", "now", "how" and all of the **color** and **number** words (zero through twenty).

* We will continue to introduce new sight words and letters every week.

Reading Folders: Please do not send reading folders back to school until your child can read the book *fluently*.

Math: Students are learning to use tally marks to record data on a chart.

Religion: The children have learned that God the Father gave us the greatest gift of all, his Son, Jesus!

Science / Social Studies: We have begun our unit on the winter season. This week we are discussing the winter weather, snowflakes and snowmen!

Computer: This third nine weeks, our kindergarteners will be learning to type their names and will get to practice their sight words using upper and lowercase letters.
