Language Arts: The letters and sounds that we have worked with are: A-a, S-s, M-m, T-t, P-p, C-c, N-n, F-f, B-b, I-i, G-g, R-r, D-d, O-o, J-j, X-x, E-e, H-h and K-k. * **Sight Words** that your child should know: "name", "I", "like", "and", "the", "a", "to", "see", "are", "we", "an", "can", "come", "me", "you", "at", "here", "is", "it", "in", "he", "she", "my", "be", "what", "with", "look", "now", "how", "find", "this", "will", "for", "go", "make", "play", "said", "good", "all", "no" and all of the color and number words (zero through twenty). We will continue to introduce new sight words and letters every week.

Reading Folders: Please do not send reading folders back to school until your child can read the book *fluently*.

Math: When we return from our Spring Break, we will begin our unit on Money. Students will recognize the value of a penny, nickel, dime, and quarter. We will practice finding the value of a group of coins, trading and comparing money amounts.

Religion: We will begin our unit on the season of Lent. The students will learn that Lent is a preparation for the celebration of Easter. It is a time of prayer and a time for loving God and others.

Science / Social Studies: We are definitely *under the weather* ☺ in Kindergarten! We have begun our unit on Weather, Texas history and famous children's author, Theodor **Seuss** Geisel. We have also planted a bean garden! We can't wait to see how much our plants grow!
