



## Kindergarten Newsletter April 25-29, 2011

We are *bugging* around the garden in Kindergarten!



**Language Arts:** Please keep practicing the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. **Sight Words** that your child should know: "name", "I", "like", "and", "the", "a", "to", "see", "are", "we", "an", "can", "come", "me", "you", "at", "here", "is", "it", "in", "he", "she", "my", "be", "what", "with", "look", "now", "how", "find", "this", "will", "for", "go", "make", "play", "said", "good", "all", "no", "do", "down", "have", "help", "off", "take", "out" and all of the color and number words (zero through twenty).

**Reading Folders:** Please do not send reading folders back to school until your child can read the book *fluently*.



**Math:** Students will compare the weight of different objects, and will use nonstandard units of length to measure.



**Religion:** The children will learn that we celebrate Jesus' new life at Easter.



**Science / Social Studies:** We will continue our unit on famous children's author, Eric Carle. We will also begin our unit on Plants. The students will learn the different parts of plants and flowers, and how they grow.

**A few reminders:**

- On **Thursday, April 21<sup>st</sup>**, we will have a **noon dismissal**. There will **not** be Friends of Jesus and Mary or After School Care. Please make the necessary arrangements for your children to be picked up on time.
- School will be **closed** on **Good Friday** (April 22) and the **Monday after Easter** (April 25).
- We will have our **Easter Egg Hunt** with our eighth grade buddies on **Tuesday, April 26<sup>th</sup>** at **9:00 a.m.** **Tuesday morning**, your child will need to bring his/her **Easter basket** and **12 individually filled eggs**.
