Language Arts: Friday, May 13th will be the last time we will send Reading Folders home. Please **return all books and reading folders by Monday, May 16th.**



Math: Students will identify and count numbers to 100. We will explore tens and ones, and will learn to skip count by 2's, 5's, and 10's.



Religion: The children will learn that Jesus is our friend and is always with us.



Science / Social Studies: We will conclude our unit on famous children's author, Eric Carle. We are also diving into the big ocean blue! Our students will learn about different ocean animals and many of the extraordinary things you can find deep in the sea!

Children will be dismissed after Field Day. Please make the necessary arrangements to have your child picked up on time.
