Fall is finally here and we are feeling *cool* in Kindergarten!!!

**Language Arts:** We continue to work on recognizing the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. We are listening to and learning nursery rhymes. The students are practicing how to write their names correctly. Please look at the handwriting pages that are coming home with your child's name on it. These will show you the correct way your child will have to write each letter of their name.

\* **Sight Words** that your child should be practicing: "name", "I", "like", "and", "the", "a", "to", "see" and all of the **color** words.

\* Remember to send **Reading Folders** back to school when your child is comfortable reading their book and is ready to read it back to his/her teacher.

**Math:** We have begun a new chapter on positional words. Collect household items and let your child practice placing them in different positions: above, below, over, on, under, inside, outside, top, middle and bottom. Please review with your student the different solid (cylinder, cone, sphere, cube and rectangular prism) and plane figures (square, circle, rectangle and triangle).

**Religion:** This week we are learning and practicing the Guardian Angel prayer and the appropriate behavior we need to display in Mass. Our kids and their 8<sup>th</sup> grade buddies are really looking forward to our Guardian Angel celebration!

**Social Studies / Science:** We are winding down our Apple Unit; we have learned so much about apples! The children are still discussing the wonderful things that make our community special like our families, the places in it and the great people that help our community thrive.
