We are having a terrific time in Kindergarten!

Language Arts: We continue to work on recognizing the letters of the alphabet and their sounds. We are listening to and learning nursery rhymes. The students are practicing how to write their names correctly. Please look at the handwriting pages that are coming home with your child's name on it. These will show you the correct way your child will have to write each letter of their name.

* The **Sight Words Packet** that came home during Open House is the complete list of sight words your child will learn this year in Kindergarten. It will be beneficial for your child to learn these words by the time they reach First Grade.

* From the list, your child should be practicing: "name", "I" and all of the color words.

* Reading Folders will begin coming home next week.

Math: The students have been sorting objects by color, size, shape and likeness.

Religion: We have been celebrating the wonderful gifts God has given us. We have discussed His gifts of Light and Water, and how we can take care of them.

Social Studies / Science: The students have been practicing the Pledge of Allegiance and the Pledge to the Texas Flag. We are also discussing families, what makes them special and their role in the community.
